The Joint License Agreement for Terminals (JLA) captures in excess of 35% of the 2005 W-CDMA handset market worldwide

Stamford, UK, 1 February 2006.

Today, 3G Licensing, the licensing administrator of the W-CDMA Patent Licensing Programme, was pleased to announce that in 2005 the W-CDMA Patent Licensing Programme had under license more than 35% of the world market for W-CDMA terminal products with a per-unit JLA royalty of US\$ 2.00.

This represented around 16 million licensed terminals in a world market of about 43.7 million terminals (according to Strategy Analytics).

Given that the W-CDMA terminal market worldwide is forecasted to grow from 44 million units in 2005 to more than 400 million units in 2010 this represents a substantial potential addressable market for the the W-CDMA Patent Licensing Programme.

All parties that make, use, lease, sell and otherwise dispose of or transfer terminals that claim to conform to the W-CDMA FDD standards including ODM, OEM and EMS manufacturers (that is, the actual manufacture of the terminal) must take either a JLA or an individual license from each patent holder under the W-CDMA Patent Licensing Programme.
