More than 21 million W-CDMA terminal devices sold under license during 2006

Stamford, UK, 1 February 2007.

Today, 3G Licensing, the licensing administrator of the W-CDMA Patent Licensing Programme, announced that more than 21 million W-CDMA terminal devices, including mobiles phones and removeable data cards, were sold under license during 2006. This represents an increase of more than 42% over the comparable number of W-CDMA terminal devices sold under license during 2005.

Nonetheless, there remains a large number of W-CDMA terminal devices being sold without a license, and the licensing administrator has made known to the concerned parties their responsibilities with respect to the certified W-CDMA Essential Patents available for licensing under the W-CDMA Patent Licensing Programme.
