

## **Announcement**

### **The JLA licensors withdraw the JLA V1.0 offer and replace with a JLA V2.0 offer incorporating enhanced back-due royalties**

**Stamford, UK, 31 March 2006.**

Today, 3G Licensing, the licensing administrator for the W-CDMA Patent Licensing Programme, announced that the current Joint License Agreement for Terminals (JLA V1.0 - version 1.0) offer is withdrawn effective immediately following an instruction from the Licensors.

Nonetheless, 3G Licensing has been instructed by the Licensors to make available a JLA V2.0 (version 2.0) offer incorporating enhanced back-due royalties effective 1 April 2006. 3G Licensing will be sending formal notifications to the prospective licensees in the near future.

The JLA offers a beneficial royalty since several Licensors group their W-CDMA Essential Patents into a single license.

The JLA V2.0 retains the many favourable features included in JLA V1.0 and, in particular, the avoidance of “double-dipping” in which no licensee pays twice to the same Licensor for the same patents, that is, a royalty exemption feature. Thus a large proportion of licensees would not pay the full per unit royalty.
