### **JLA royalty for 2007 and 2008**

#### **Publication of Joint License Agreement for Terminals Version 3.0 (JLAV3.0)**

**Stamford, UK, 31 July 2006.**

Today, 3G Licensing, the licensing administrator of the W-CDMA Patent Licensing Programme, announced the publication of the Joint License Agreement for Terminals Version 3.0 (JLAV3.0) for the period 1 January 2007 to 31 December 2008.

JLAV3.0 incorporates a per unit royalty structure for the period 1 January 2007 to 31 December 2008 which reflects the anticipated decline in prices of W-CDMA terminal products and the significant price variation for different W-CDMA terminal product types. In addition, JLAV3.0 covers removable data cards and embedded data cards for portable computers and notebooks.

The royalty for each Licensed Product (W-CDMA terminal product) is the lower of (1) 1.5% of the Net Selling Price per unit with a minimum of U.S. \$1.5 or (2) U.S. \$3.0 per unit.

The JLAV3.0 has been sent to those prospective licensees that are already in contact with 3G Licensing. Copies of JLAV3.0 may be obtained upon request.

The licensors have retained the royalty exemption feature whereby existing licensing agreements with specific licensors are respected. The licensee only pays a royalty once, either under JLAV3.0 or a separate licensing agreement with a specific licensor or licensors.

All parties that make, use, lease, sell and otherwise dispose of or transfer W-CDMA terminal products that claim to conform to the W-CDMA FDD standards, including ODM, OEM and EMS manufacturers, should take either JLAV3.0 or an individual license from each patent holder under the W-CDMA Patent Licensing Programme.
